Information or Calculations for Each Column:

Column 1: Graduating Class of 2014 (indicate earliest year of your 5 year period (2014))

Column 2: Program Completion Percentage (do this calculation last)

Column 3: Original No. of Admitted Students: (These are the number of students that actually started the first semester of the Program.)

Column 4: Revised number of Admitted Students: (If you have some students that withdrew the first semester prior to or by the published last day to withdraw), exclude the number of those students from the original number of admitted students) Make sure you save the names of the students that withdrew early to make sure you have documentation.

Column 5: Number of students dismissed for grades: This is the number of students that failed any course in the Program during the two years.
